



REGENERATION AND AMPLIFICATION.

Magnification of the incoming radio signals through the cumulative strengthening properties of the regenerative circuit and further building up of the signals by the use of audio-frequency amplification provides a very efficient and satisfactory method of securing amplification of music or speech.

In the accompanying diagram regeneration is obtained by the magnetic coupling of a tickler coil placed in inductive relation to the grid circuit of the first tube. It is important that the tickler and, secondary coils have the proper relative polarity, otherwise the radio-frequency current which flows through the tickler coil would decrease rather than increase the strength of oscillation.

The correct polarity relation between the coils may be determined experimentally and the incoming signal after being directly amplified by the tube is further reinforced by the radio-frequency current which flows through the tickler coil and strengthens the oscillation in the grid circuit.

ESCAPES POLICE CORDON.

Massachusetts Fugitive, After Leap Through Window, Kludes Dog.

Woodsocket, R. I., Dec. 5.—Leaping through a closed window amid a shower of flying glass in view of a cordon of Woonsocket police and Massachusetts State officers reinforced by a German police dog, Isador Guilbault, sought in connection with the killing of Albert Touchette in a grocery store hold-up last night in Blackstone, Mass, made good his escape into the neighboring woods. A fire alarm was sounded and a riot call sent in summoning all available police officers.

Touchette was shot and fatally wounded when a bandit entered his store and demanded money. State police conducted an unsuccessful search, but the Woonsocket police got a tip that a man had been seen limping into a cert tain house, which they surrounded.

Guilbault, who was seated at a Thanksgiving dinner when the cordon was drawn about the place, ran to the rear of the house, leaped through a closed window and before police realized what was happening was almost out of sight. The police dog, brought to town early for the occasion, loped after the fugitive, but a few hours later trotted back alone.

Guilbault's father and mother said their son had gone to see his sweetheart, Yvonne Martin, who lives not fair from the scene of the hold-up. They said he did not return, but remained at the girl's home all night. The Martin girl corroborated this statement.

The hold-up and shooting came as a climax to a series of robberies by armed bandits in this vicinity recently.
