That such reports be read by the secretary of the Synod, and that a committee be appointed to draw up a report on the state of the diocese, based upon the information afforded by these parochial reports, and that a committee be named by his Lordship to draw up such a form, have them printed and furnished to the clergy of the diocese, to be filled up by them."
