RESOLVED,—That the Rules for the preservation of order recommended by the Committee, shall be in force during this session of the Synod.—Carried.

The Bishop called the attention of the Synod to the By-Law of the Church Society of Toronto, for administering and disposing of two separate Trust Funds for the support of the Episcopate in the Eastern and Western parts of this Province, formerly constituting Upper Canada; by which it is appointed in the 8th clause, "that whenever any person or persons capable of holding and administering such funds, shall have been constituted or appointed within either of such new Dioceses, the Trust Committee thereof, and the Church Society, shall, on being required by the Synod of such Diocese, assign all the securities, pay over all the monies and deliver up all the books, vouchers and property appertaining to such funds to such person or persons as aforesaid."
