Passed Flushing, May 29, bark Kentikera. **REPORTS.** Beifast, Ireland, May 27-The inquiry of the Board of Trade into the loss of the Brit-ish bark British American, Captain McOul-lough, which was abandoned at sea on April 29, while on a voyage from Mobile, Ala, to this port, is in progress here. Sev-eral of the crew declared the vessel was utterly unseaworthy on the previous voyage, when the pumps had to be worked twenty minutes hourly. On her return voyage, the seamen added, the pumps of the British American had to be worked night and day.
