C H A P. XV.

An Act to Establish a Market in the Town of Perth, in the County of Carleton.

## [Passed 17th January, 1822.]

WHEREAS it is expedient for the convenience of the inhabitants of the County of Carleton that a Market should be established at Perth in the said county: Be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain entituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, entituled, 'An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province," and by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this Act, a Market shall be established and kept in the town of Perth, in the county aforesaid.
