Bill adopted by the House on 23rd June, 1887, copies of which may be obtained from the Clerk of the House.

If not in accord with Model Bill.

(a) The provisions contained in any bill which are not in accord with the Model Bill, shall be inserted between brackets, and when revised by the proper officer shall be so printed, and bills which are not in accordance with this Rule shall be returned to the promoters to be re-cast before being revised and printed;

Sections amended.

(b.) Any sections of existing Acts which are proposed to be amended shall be re-printed in full with the amendments inserted in their proper places and beween brackets;

Exceptional provisions.

(c.) Any exceptional provisions that it may be proposed to insert in any Bill shall be clearly specified in the Notice of Application for the same. 3.723

Railway Bills. 51B. No bill for the incorporation of a Railway Company, or for changing the route of the railway of any company already incorporated, shall be considered by the Railway Committee until there has been fyled with the Committee, at least one week before the consideration of the Bill:—
