An Act to amend the Naturalization Laws of this Province.

HEREAS it is expedient to shorten the period of continued residence Preamble. required by the fourth section of the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled An Act to repeal a certain Act therein 12 Vic.c. 197. mentioned, and to make better provision for the Naturalization of Aliens, on the part of Aliens not coming within the scope of the second and third sections of the said Act, before such Aliens are entitled to become naturalized subjects of Her Majesty: Be it therefore enacted, etc., as follows:

That the Act cited in the preamble, shall hereafter be construed and have Time of resieffect as if the period limited for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned in dence requithe fourth section thereof were "years or upwards," instead of ralization "seven years or upwards," and the words of the oath to be taken under shortened. 10 the fourth section thereof were " section five of the said Act, or in any certificate or other proceeding under the same, may be varied accordingly.
