An Act to continue for a limited time the several Acts and Ordinances therein mentioned.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to continue the Preamble. Acts hereinafter mentioned, which would otherwise expire at the end of the present Session;—Be it therefore enacted, &c.

5 And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Act of the Parliament of this Province passed in the Session held in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to regulate the* 4 and 5 Vict. c. 58. "*Inspection of Beef and Pork*":—

10 And the Act of the said Parliament passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An* 5 Vict. c. 6. "*Act for the better preservation of the Peace, and the prevention of riots and violent outrages at or near Public Works while in progress of construction*":—

15 And the Act of the said Parliament passed in the same year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to* 8 Vict. c. 27. "*amend the Act and Ordinance therein mentioned relative to the Registration of Titles to and incumbrances upon Real Property in Lower Canada*":—

20 And the Act of the said Parliament passed in the same year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act for* 8 Vict. c. 43. "*the relief of Insolvent Debtors in Upper Canada, and for other purposes therein mentioned*":—

25 And the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An* 9 Vict. 38. "*Act to empower Commissioners for inquiring into matters connected with the public business to take evidence on oath*":—

30 And the Act of the Parliament of the late Province of Lower Canada, passed in the second year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, and intituled, "*An Act for better regulating the Common of the Seignior* 2 Geo. 4, c. 8. "*of Laprairie de la Madeleine*":—

35 And the Act of the said Parliament passed in the same year of the same Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to en-* 2 Geo. 4, c. 10. as amended and extended by. "*able the inhabitants of the Seignior of La Baie Saint Antoine, commonly called La Baie du Fèbre, to provide for the better regulation of the Common in the said*
