BILL.

An Act for putting a legislative Interpretation upon certain terms used in Acts of Parliament, and for rendering it unnecessary to repeat certain provisions and expressions therein, and for ascertaining the date and commencement thereof, and for other purposes.

THEREAS it is desirable to avoid, Preamble. by the establishment of some general rules for the interpretation of Acts of 4 the Provincial Parliament, the continual repetition therein of words, phrases and a clauses, which are rendered necessary solely by the want of such rules, and also g to provide for the date and commencement of such Acts being known with certainty: Be 10 it therefore enacted, &c. And it is hereby By what name enacted by the authority of the same, that 12 this Act shall be known, cited and referred to what Acts to as "The Interpretation Act," and that 14 each provision thereof shall extend and apply to each Act passed in this present 16 Session or in any future Session of the Provincial Parliament, except in so far as 18 any such provision shall be inconsistent with the intent and object of such Act, or 20 the interpretation which such provision would give to any word, expression or 22 clause shall be inconsistent with the context; and except in so far as this Act or 24 any provision thereof shall in any such Act be declared not applicable thereto; 26 nor shall the omission in any Act of a declaration that this Act shall apply there-28 to, be construed to prevent its so applying.
