Your faithful Commons, assured of the Justice and the equity of Parliament, attribute the passing of those Acts to the information conveyed to Your Majesty's Ministers and to the Parliament itself, by ill informed or evil intentioned persons, and feel confident that had the truth been known to that illustrious Body, they never would have agreed to the adoption of measures so unjust in themselves, and so adverse to the just Rights of Your Majesty's Subjects in this part of the Empire.

And your faithful Commons therefore humbly pray, that Your Majesty will be favourable to their humble prayer, and will be graciously pleased to recommend to Your Imperial Parliament the repeal of the two Acts above mentioned, in so far as they relate to the Tenure

of Lands.
