

## BILL.

An Act to repeal certain Acts therein mentioned, and to make further provision respecting Emigrants.

**WHEREAS** it is necessary to repeal certain Acts hereinafter mentioned, and to make such further provision with reference to Emigration as will tend to prevent the introduction into this Province of a Pauper Emigration labouring under disease, and at the same time to encourage the introduction of a more healthy and useful class of Emigrants: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

10 And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Act of the Legislature of this Province passed in the Session held in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to create a Fund for defraying the expense of enabling Indigent Emigrants to proceed to their place of destination, and of supporting them until they can procure employment,*"—and the Act of the said Legislature, passed in the eleventh year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to make better provision with respect to Emigrants, and for defraying the expenses of supporting Indigent Emigrants, and of forwarding them to their place of destination, and to amend the Act therein mentioned,*"—be and the same are hereby repealed.

II. And be it enacted, That there shall be raised, levied and collected, a rate or duty, payable in the manner hereinafter prescribed, by the master or person in command of every vessel arriving in the Port of Quebec or in the Port of Montreal from any Port of the United Kingdom or of any other part of Europe, with Passengers or Emigrants there-
