the next Session, and in the meantime the Bill be printed for public information.

An Act to repeal and amend the several Assessment Laws of this Province, so far as the same relate to or affect the City of Toronto or the Liberties thereof.

[As sent up from the Assembly.]

Whereas the several Laws now inforce relative to the levying and collecting Rates and Assessments within this Province, have, in their application to the City of Toronto, been found to produce well-founded complaint on the part of the inhabitants of the said City, and it is therefore expedient to provide for the more equal and just levying of Rates and Assessments in the said City: And whereas, it is also expedient that the whole of the Rates and Assessments rated and assessed on property within the said City, should be paid and applied to the uses of the said City, the said City paying to the general funds of the Home District a certain yearly sum as the just proportion which the said City ought to bear and pay in the general expenses of the said District: And whereas, the several Laws of this Province relating to Road or Statute Labour will, in consequence of the repeal of the Assessment Laws
