Oshweken Council House.  
August 8<sup>th</sup> 1894.

Six Nation Indians  
To Josiah Still for travelling expenses,  
examining Roads, Bridges, Ditches and  
Culverts, as follows.

- Feb 4 Visited a small bridge over a small creek  
near Jasper & Jones on Delaware line and  
found the bridge requires one new bent, new  
wings, new covering and widening the em-  
bankment  $1\frac{1}{4}$  Chain long. 9 miles. .90
- " 9 Went by request to Spring Creek and found  
the old bridge to be too far gone to be repaired  
took measurement for a new bridge  $5\frac{1}{4}$  long.  
15 miles. \$1.50
- " 14 By request of Contractor Visited the Del  
bridge, directed how the work should be done,  
thence to the boundary line and examined  
3 Culverts. 18 miles. " 1.80
- " 15 Visited bridge No 7. over McKenzie Creek  
and examined, the stringers after the covering  
was removed, condemned a portion of  
the railings. 5 miles. .50
- " 21 Again Visited bridge No 7. and found  
the work completed according to plan  
and specification. 5 miles. .50
- Mar 12 Went to Delaware bridge and examined  
the work, as required. 14 miles. " 1.40
