Kingston 6th February 1819

On my applying to the Comptroler for my allowance of Rations I received the following Answer, viz.

"As the General Order for your appointment does not state you are to receive the usual allowance, it will be necessary for you to request the Head of your Department to have an Order issued to that effect, authorizing you also to draw your back rations from the period of your Appointment."

My Appointment commenced the 25th April last, and I have received every allowance except Rations.

May I beg of you to take such steps as to you may seem meet to obtain the necessary Order as above mentioned.
