MR. KING:

Mr. W. T. R. Preston called at 2.30 today to say that he had had a talk with Hon. James Robb, Minister of Trade and Commerce and Hon. W. R. Motherwell, with reference to the proposal mentioned in the attached memorandum which was submitted to Mr. Robb some days ago. Mr. Preston stated that Mr. Robb favored the project but believed that it was on such a wide scale that it ought to go, not through his Department, but through the Prime Minister.
