



Ottawa 26th September, 1903.

Sir,

I return herewith the original and duplicate pay-lists of the distribution of interest money to the Michipicotten Band for the Spring of 1903. I also send a copy of the interest pay-list for the same Band for June 1898. There having been no interest distributed to those Indians between June 1898 and the spring of 1903. In June 1898 there were 333 names on the pay-list. The pay-lists which you prepared for 1903 shew the number of persons ~~xxxx~~ paid as 363. It will be necessary for you to account in the proper column (making explanations where necessary in the "Remarks" column) for all increases. You should not have made payment before receiving the list for 1898 to be used as a guide.
