Rev. Sir:

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant referring the Department of your appointment as principal of the Chapleau Indian Boarding School, and in reply, I beg to say that the same has been noted.

You should make out a requisition of the school material you require on the forms sent you under a separate cover for that purpose. A supply of quarterly school returns and forms of application for admission are also being sent you.

You should state what repairs are needed for the closets and furnish an estimate of the probable cost. Articles for use around the school, such as axes and tools of a general nature will have to be provided by the school out of the per capita grant.

The other matters referred to in your letter will be taken up with his Lordship the Bishop of Moosonee.
