In raply I have to inform you that the Department of Militia and Defence has reported that the Indians referred to in the petition, namely, Robert Sky, James Williams, H. Fish, W. Fish and J. Bumberry, are all above the age of 18 years; that they are on service overseas, and that it is not proposed to apply for their discharge.
