WHO SAYS:

On the 24th February, 1963, about 22.00 hours, I went out to see what direction the boat was following. On the top of the boat 3 persons directed to me the stream of light of torches. They asked if the safe was open whereupon I said "No". They threw me inside. Two were with a pistol in their hand. The third took the money from the people get present. I saw a chance to close my drawer. One asked me for cigar and 2000 frs. I didn't give anything and ran chance to run away to call the Police. When coming back I found out that they had taken 20 frs. I recognized certain one of the three, the one who menaced me with the pistol, for the second I cannot say for certain.
