On Joly 7th while the plane was flying at Arran, Sask. (pilot W.B.Carss Jr.) it failed to gain altitude on the take-off. One wing hit a tree, threw the plane off course and it landed in a bush, damaging wings, fusilage and undercarriage quite seriously, but the pilot and passengers were not hurt.

I reported the accident to Western Aircraft Co. in Winnipeg Man. by telegram and asked them to notify the Insurance Company and the Transport Boatd. The adjuster arrived in Kamsack on the 9th, obtained a full report and returned to Winnipeg that evening. I feel quite sure that the Department of Transport in Winnipeg have been notified of the accident but as yet we have heard nothing whatever from them. I left it more or less to Mr. Grant of Western Aircraft to notify them, and I regret very much the delay if they have not been notified.
