## COMPLAINTS.

1. Any Non-Commissioned Officer or soldier having a complaint will make it to the officer in charge of his company before bringing the same to the notice of the commanding officer of the Regiment.

-2. Any one who makes the complaint and appears to be under the influence of liquor, or seeming excited and out of temper, should on no account be brought before the officer.

## COLOR OR PAY SERGEANT.

1. The duties are various, and he is chosen for his fitness for the office, by the officer commanding the company.

2. He has to bring to his commanding officer's notice any derelection of duty on the part of the non-commissioned officers and privates of the company, and report as well any irregularity in the same.
