LANDS FOR EVERYBODY.

Potatoes, Cabbage, Carrots..

POTATO disease may generally be checked or prevented by a judicious use of salt, which also acts as a solvent of potash compounds, and keeps off the grubs.

ABBAGE and CARROTS require 300 to 700 lbs. salt per acre, in proportion to the lightness of the soil. Kohl-rabi requires similar quantities.
