

\*GOSSIP. J. 1. MEYER'S INCUBATORS AND POULTRY, SHORTHORNS AND COTSWOLDS. As Mr. J. E. Meyer, near Kossuth, Ont., has made a special study of the rearing and devel-oping of fancy poultry, he has also given a corresponding amount of attention to the requirements of incubators, and is at present engaged in the manufacture of a machine which is the result of years of experimental work and practical use. While visiting the factory a short time ago we were shown the special points, which are claimed as superior to other incubators; and as Mr. Meyer guaran-tees his machine to give entire satisfaction, and to be perfectly automatic, we feel that he knows just what he is talking about. 
