That this House do now adjourn,

The House divided thereon:

Yeas 5 Nays 10

So it passed in the negative.

And the main question being put, a division again ensued,

Yeas 10 Nays 5

And the same being carried in the affirmative.

Ordered, That the faid Edward Edwards be taken into custody of the Serjeant at Arms attending upon this House,

And then, upon motion of Mr. Mure, seconded by Mr. Berthelot,

The House adjourned to Monday next.
