To meet this difficulty several states have made special ex-ceptions to their laws. It appears that in the nine states and four provinces 3.336 nonresident big game licenses were issued in 1903 at a cost of \$72,294 that Maine issued more than onethird of the fees, and that New-Brunswick stood second in point of he n-e receipts. 
