The Bishop of Huron, in a masterly address to the combined gathering of the Anglican Young Peoples' Associations of the Anglican Church, held in the Cronyn Memorial Church on Thursday evening, outlined to the young people what their duty was in breaking down the prevailing misconceptions relating to their church.

The bishop referred to the A. Y. P. A, as one of the most hopeful features in church life, and stated that there were two prevailing misconceptions in regard to the Church of England, which they were to fight against. The first misbelief was that only a paper wall existed between it and a certain other church. In reply to this, he would say that the Church of England bore the brunt of the fight against the religious errors of the mediaeval period. It was their denomination which gave the Bible to the people of the world.

The other misconception was that the church was not a spiritual factor in Christianity. This was partly due to the church's attitude toward amusements. Some people thought that religion consisted of a number of negative commandments, such as don't smoke, don't dance, don't play cards,

Instead of this, the bishop stated that the church taught that religion positive thing, dealing with the inward man, and those factors which aided in building up a being, which was developed from all standpoints. In conclusion, he pointed out that the hope of the Anglican Church was based on the young people. The bishop was accorded a hearty vote of thanks
