

THE LOCAL MARKET

Today being Farmers' Day at the Western Fair, the market was very small this morning, but a dozen loads of hay, a few loads of new oats, and one load of wheat making up the entire market.

New oats went up two cents a hundredweight this morning, and are now selling at \$1.60 per hundredweight.

One load of wheat sold for \$1.15 per bushel, while the remainder at the old prices.

Dressed hogs are a little cheaper. Yesterday afternoon the price dropped from \$12.25 to \$12.00, to \$11.50. There was a fair demand.

No. 2 peaches were a little cheaper this morning, selling at 60 cents a basket. The larger peaches sold at \$1.

WHEAT.
Chicago, Sept. 15.—Wheat advanced sharply today, principally on account of higher quotations at Liverpool. Reports that representatives of foreign governments were bidding for 100,000 barrels of flour, and also to lift the market. Besides, country acceptances of offers from here were meagre.

WHEAT RECEIPTS.
Montreal, Sept. 15.—Wheat receipts, 244,924 bushels.

Winnipeg, Sept. 15.—Trading on the wheat market was quiet in the early hours of today's session, and only a light volume in futures was transacted. Futures opened fairly steady, following Monday's close, and were stronger generally, ranging from 1 1/4 to 1 3/4. No. 2 peaches were a little cheaper this morning, selling at 60 cents a basket. The larger peaches sold at \$1.

War news had considerable effect on prices, and a drop took place of about 10 when the big German reverse was rumored on the exchange. Prices recovered later, however, on the news standing unconfirmed.

Closing prices were 1 1/4 to 2 1/4 higher for wheat, and 1 1/2 to 2 1/2 for oats. The cash demand for wheat was again poor today, the only grade wanted being No. 1 northern. There were quite equal to the demand for No. 2 and No. 3. Exports were quiet. Exporters were doing nothing, practically. Cash grains closed: Wheat, 1 1/4 to 1 3/4 higher; oats, 1 to 1 1/2 lower; and No. 2 feed, 1 1/2 to 1 3/4 higher.
