

NORMAL STUDENTS TRY EXAMINATION

**Paper Is Issued by Department
On Religious Education.**

Approximately 300 Normal School students wrote on an examination dealing with religious education yesterday afternoon, the paper being issued by the department of religious education of the provincial Normal schools and one of the standard teaching course.

The paper consisted of seven questions, of which four were to be answered, the time limit being 40 minutes. The students were from the Methodist, Presbyterian and Baptist denominations. Rev. W. Reid, Rev. Mr. Murphy, Mr. Hoffar and Miss Graham presided.

The first question asked why the gospels were central in the Sunday school curriculum, while the second asked for the content of Jesus' teaching on the Kingdom of God.

The personality of Christ was dealt with in the next question, while the adaptability of stories of Christ for little children was also on the list, the reason for this being asked. Question five asked what form the presentation of Christ to the juniors should take. What the little children's biography make use of, especially service to the community, and religious education of intermediates was another question, while the students were asked, in the last, to state the general principles that should determine the selection of lesson courses for young people.

FORMER LONDON MAN CONVICTED AT WINDSOR

Hughson Johnstone Sentenced To 15 Days On Larceny Charge.

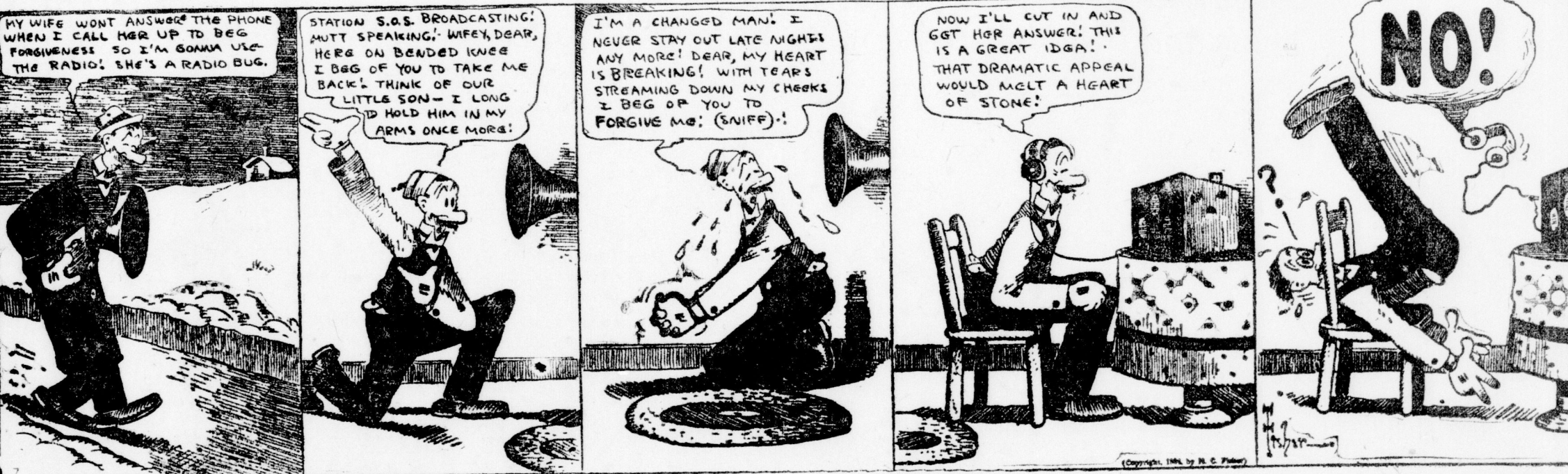
