WASHINGTON, April 22.—Acting-Adjutant Kelton late this afternoon received the following despatch, bearing on the situation in Oklahoma, from Major-General Crook, dated Chicago, April 22: "Assistant Adjutant-General, Department Missouri, telegraphs under date of the 21st that he is just in receipt of a despatch from General Merritt at Oklahoma in which he says: "He will probably need no more troops forwarded; that he is sure a show of force will prevent trouble, and that the newspaper accounts are probably exagger-tated, and will continue to the so. He reports much confusion on the line of the railroad, but he has established a line of couriers between Oklahoma station and Fort Reno, so that hereafter communication can be had with certainty and fair rapidity.

ON TO OKLAHOMA.
