NOW KNOW YE, that for divers causes and considerations, and taking into consideration the case and convenience of Our loving subjects, We have thought fit by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of the Province of British Columbia to hereby convoke, and by these presents enjoin you, and cach of you, that on Thursday, the tenth day of the month of February, one thousand eight hundred and ninetycight, you meet Us in Our said Legislature of Parliament of Our said Province, at Our City of Victoria, Folk THE DISPATCH OF BUSINESS, to treat, do, act, and conclude upon those things which in Our Legislature of the Province of British Columbia, by the Contron Council of Our said Province may by the favor of God, be ordained.

In Testimony Whereof, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Scal of the said Province to be hereunto afflixed: Witness, the Honorable Thomas R. McInnes, Licutemant-Governor of Our said Province of British Columbia, in Our City of Victoria, in Our said Province, this thirtieth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, and in the sixty-first year of Our Reign.
