Holy Orders; One MCCAWLEY Testimonial

One Cogswell Cricket prize. The neces-
sary expenses of Board, Rooms, &c., aver-
age \$40 per annum. Nominated students
do not pay tuition fees. These nomina-
tions fifty in number, are open to all Matricu-
lated Students, and are worth about \$900
for the three years course. All Matricu-
lated Students are required to reside in Col-
lege unless specially exempted. The Pro-
fessor resides within the limits of the Uni-
versity grounds.


