PROTOCOL

TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA ON TRADE AND COMMERCE

The Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of Lithuania, having had consultations on the Agreement between the British and Lithuanian Governments respecting Commercial Relations, concluded at Riga and Kaunas on May 6, 1922;

Predicating the non-recognition of the illegal incorporation of Lithuania into the former Soviet Union;

Recognizing the continued validity between the United Kingdom and the Republic of Lithuania of the Agreement between the British and Lithuanian Governments respecting Commercial Relations;

Bearing in mind that certain provisions of the Agreement between the British and Lithuanian Governments respecting Commercial Relations were extended to trade relations between Canada and Lithuania on September 15, 1928;

Taking into account that the Agreement concluded in 1922 does not fully reflect the new state of affairs in bilateral Canadian-Lithuanian relations;

Noting that the Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of Lithuania have executed simultaneouly with the execution of this Protocol an Agreement on Trade and Commerce:
