

## ARTICLE VI

Articles the growth, produce or manufacture of Canada or Costa Rica shall, after importation into the other country, be exempt from all internal taxes, fees, charges or exactions other or higher than those payable on like articles of any other foreign origin.

## ARTICLE VII

- (a) In the event that the Government of either country ceases to grant most-favoured-nation treatment to a third country through which merchandise proceeding from Canada to Costa Rica, or vice versa, moves in transit, or adopts any measure which, even though it does not conflict with the terms of this Agreement, is considered by the Government of the other country as tending to nullify or impair any of its objects, the Government which has adopted such a measure shall consider such representations and proposals as the other Government may make and shall afford adequate opportunity for consultation with a view to reaching a mutually satisfactory agreement.
- (b) The Government of each country shall accord friendly consideration to such representations as the other Government may make with respect to the operation of customs regulations, control of foreign exchange, quantitative restrictions or the administration thereof, the observance of customs formalities, the application of sanitary laws and regulations for the protection of human, animal or plant health or life, or any other matter related to the application of this Agreement. Each Government, when requestd, shall afford adequate opportunity for consultation regarding such representations.
- (c) If agreement is not reached after due consultation, as described above, either Government shall be at liberty to denounce this Agreement in whole or in part and the termination shall take effect upon the expiration of a period of three months reckoned from the day on which written notice of such denunciation is received by the other Government.

## ARTICLE VIII

The present Commercial Modus Vivendi shall remain in effect for one year, and thereafter subject to denunciation by either Government at any time on three months' prior notice to the other Government.

This Note, together with the favourable reply of Your Excellency, shall constitute a Commercial Modus Vivendi between Canada and Costa Rica which shall go into effect as soon as it has been approved by the Legislative Assembly of the Republic of Costa Rica and has been published in the Official Gazette of Costa Rica.

I take this opportunity of expression to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest and most distinguished consideration.
