TREATY

BETWEEN

THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

AND

THE GOVERNMENT OF MONGOLIA

ON

THE TRANSFER OF OFFENDERS

THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF MONGOLIA, hereinafter referred to as the "Parties";

AGREEING on the necessity of mutual cooperation in the administration of justice; and

DESIRING to facilitate the social reintegration of offenders by allowing them to serve their sentences in the country of which they are citizens,

HAVE AGREED to the following:

ARTICLE I

Scope of Application

- Sentences imposed in Mongolia on Canadian citizens may be served in Canada in penal institutions or under the supervision of Canadian authorities in accordance with the provisions of this Treaty.
- Sentences imposed in Canada on Mongolian citizens may be served in Mongolia
 in penal institutions or under the supervision of Mongolian authorities in
 accordance with the provisions of this Treaty.

ARTICLE II

Definitions

For the purposes of this Treaty:

- (a) "Sentencing State" means the Party from which the offender is to be transferred;
- (b) "Receiving State" means the Party to which the offender is to be transferred:
- (c) "Offender" means a person who, in the territory of either Party, has been sentenced and is serving a term of imprisonment, a term of conditional release, or any other form of community supervision; and
