

The Bill No. 106 (Letter Q-1 of the Senate), intituled: "An Act to amend the Quebec Savings Banks Act", was considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, read the third time and passed.

The Order being read for the second reading of Bill No. 159, An Act to amend the Canadian Farm Loan Act;

Mr. Harris moved,—That the said Bill be now read the second time.

After debate thereon; the question being put on the said motion, it was agreed to.

The said Bill was accordingly read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole and reported without amendment.

By unanimous consent, the said Bill was read the third time and passed.

The Order being read for the second reading of Bill No. 161, An Act to amend the Department of Northern Affairs and National Resources Act;

Mr. Fleming raised a point of order to the effect that the said Bill provided for an expenditure which had not been recommended to the House by His Excellency the Governor General in the Resolution adopted on February 22 last.

And a debate arising on the point of order;

Order numbered 10, having been called, was allowed to stand.

The Order being read for the second reading of Bill No. 8, An Act to amend the Interest Act;

Mr. Argue, seconded by Mr. Knowles, moved,—That the said Bill be now read the second time.

And a debate arising thereon; the said debate was, on motion of Mr. Nicholson, adjourned.

The hour for Private and Public Bills having expired.

The House resumed consideration of the point of order raised by Mr. Fleming with regard to Bill No. 161, An Act to amend the Department of Northern Affairs and National Resources Act.

By unanimous consent, Mr. Lesage, seconded by Mr. Harris, moved,—That the Order for the second reading of the said Bill be allowed to stand, that lines 20 to 23 inclusive of the said Bill be deleted, and that the said Bill be reprinted.

And the question being put on the said motion, it was agreed to.
