Mr. Ralston—On Thursday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—1. What are the projects in the Province of Nova Scotia towards which money from the \$20,000,000 Unemployment Relief Fund was paid?

2. What were the amounts paid to each project?

3. In the case of provincial undertakings respecting highways, bridges, specify particularly the termini of the portion of highway on which the expenditure was authorized or made?

Mr. Ralston—On Thursday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—Was federal money paid to the following projects, and, if so, how much in each case: (a) project for an expenditure towards sewers in the town of Pictou; (b) project for expenditure towards road-building or maintenance in the town of Westville, Pictou county; (c) project for expenditure towards building a bridge in the town of New Glasgow; (d) highway maintenance or construction in the vicinity of Woods Harbour, Shelburne county; (e) project for expenditure in connection with the Alma-Sylvester Bridge, Pictou county; (f) diversion of road, Marshy Hope, Pictou county?
