Dear Dr. Ruttan:-

I have received the following report from
the National Committee for the Training of Teachers:-

"That in view of the nature of the investigations undertaken
by Mr. MacOdrum, his studentship be extended to cover Session
1926-27, two Sessions being considered the minimum time for the
effective pursuance of the line of study on which he is engaged,
the recommendation being made subject to the approval of the
authorities of McGill University..

"That further reports be received on the work of Mr. Gower
at McGill University, and if it be found that Mr. Gower's line of
study necessitates two Sessions, as in the case of Mr. MacOdrum, the
same privilege be extended to Mr. Gower as to Mr. MacOdrum".

Will you let me know whether Mr. Gower will get his
degree aegrotat at the end of this year if he does not recover from
his present illness; if not what recommendation have you to make as
regards the continuation of his scholarship?
