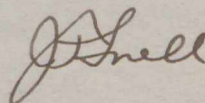
In accordance with your instructions, I have asked Mr. Ward to confer with you regarding the salaries of Professors Ness and Crampton, and the cut in wages of employees of the College.

I have written Dr. Barton inquiring about the question of expenses to the National Agricultural Conference to be held in Regina, July 20th to 24th. This is a meeting of the Ministers of Agriculture and the National Advisory Committee on Agricultural Services, organized at a conference held in Toronto, August 29th to September 1st, 1932; the object being to coordinate the activities of the Dominion and Provincial Departments and of the agricultural and veterinary colleges in the interests of economy and efficiency. I have a copy of the official report of last year's conference, which I shall be glad to send you if you would care to see it.

A meeting of the Canadian Seed Growers' Association will be held concurrently with the International Conference and a meeting of the Canadian Society of Technical Agriculturists will follow, immediately after which the World's Grain Exhibition and Conference will be held.

I will bring this matter before you again after hearing from Dr. Barton.
