

or may be otherwise known as follows, that is to say, to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, with the building or buildings erected, or to be erected thereon, and all the appurtenances and privileges thereof, to them, the said trustees and their successors in the said trust, forever, for the site of a church, meeting-house and burying-ground, for the use of the members of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Canada, according to the rules and discipline which now are, or hereafter may be, adopted by the General Conference of the said Church in Canada, in trust and confidence that the said trustees for the time being shall at all times hereafter permit any Methodist Episcopal minister or preacher, or ministers or preachers, he or they being a member or members of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Canada; and duly authorized as such by the General or Annual Conference, to preach and perform religious service in the said house, and burial service in the said burying-ground according to the rules and discipline of the said Church; and in farther trust and confidence that the said trustees for the time being may, at their discretion, permit the regular minister or preacher of any other orthodox Protestant denomination of Christians to preach and perform public religious service in each house, when it shall not be required for the use of the ministers or preachers of the said Methodist Episcopal Church in Canada; and it is hereby declared to be the true
