Morning and Evening Stars 1873.

Mercury (♀) will be a Morning Star until 15th February; an Evening Star from 26th February till 5th April; a Morning Star till 8th June; an Evening Star from 18th June till 12th August; a Morning Star from 15th August till 21st September; an Evening Star from 25th September till close of November; thence Morning Star.

Venus (♀) will appear as an Evening Star from beginning of the year till May 1st; she will for the remainder of the year appear as a Morning Star.

Mars (♂) will be a Morning Star till end of April; an Evening Star thence.

Jupiter (♃)—a Morning Star till middle of February; from that time an Evening Star till 1st September; for the residue of the year a Morning Star.

Saturn (♄)—An Evening Star till 10th January; a Morning Star thence till 22d July; when he to the end of the year appears an Evening Star.
