CONSTITUTION

OF THE

WYCLIFFE COLLEGE ASSOCIATION.

1. The object of the Association shall be, to further in every possible way the interests, and promote the usefulness of Wycliffe College; and, with this end in view, to circulate information respecting its condition, aims, purposes, and prospects, so as to secure general sympathy and support, to collect funds by means of annual subscriptions, and by donations and bequests, and in all other ways to promote its efficiency and prosperity.

2. Every annual subscriber (under such By-Laws as may be adopted) shall be a member of the Association.

3. Every one who has heretofore, or who shall hereafter contribute to the College a sum not less than one hundred dollars shall be a Life Member of the Association.
