Kingston Liberals Tried to Heckle Sir Charles.

THE INTERRUPTIONS WERE MANY

Someone Caused the Fire Alarm Bells to be Sounded.

In the Hopes of Creating Confusion, but Mr. McIntyre informed the meeting that it was a trick. The Premier held his ground and showed up the shortcoming of the Opposition.

Kingston, June 8.—Very noisy was the gathering in the City Hall to-night addressed by Sir Charles Tupper and D. McIntyre. The Premier arrived at 7.30 o'clock from Brockville, and after the reception at the station and a serenade by the 14th P.W.O. Rifles band was conducted to the City Hall, which was densely crowded. He was cordially received by Mr. James Swift, President of the Conservative Association, presided.

After a brief selection Mr. Donald McIntyre, Conservative candidate, made the opening address, occupying an hour in reviewing the Manitoba school question, and giving his reasons for maintaining and supporting the action of the late Government. He declared for the upholding of the constitution and the restoration of the rights ruthlessly taken away from the Catholic minority in Manitoba. He called upon Liberal-Conservatives not to be turned aside by a side wind, as the question undoubtedly was, but to recall the other momentous question and maintain the principle of the late policy. If the party was united victory was assured.

During Mr. McIntyre's address the fire alarm rang. Mr. McIntyre said it was a trick of the enemy, and asked the citizens to remain. Several times as he spoke the name of "Liberals" applause followed.

Respecting Sir Charles. Sir Charles Tupper was warmly received, and from the start suffered severe heckling. He began with expressing his third content, when a voice roared out, "It will be worse on the 13th of June." Cheers and counter-cheers followed as Sir Charles questioned the prophecy and told his friend not to boast until he had laid off his armor. He thanked Sir John Macdonald, who regretted his absence from the reception, and the achievements of his party, and in a few words, he declared the Liberals had no policy, and the disturbance began, while Mr. Simmonds declared the Liberals' policy was to have honest government. Then Sir Charles retorted that the Liberals had no policy, in fact a policy in each province, and all with the same end in view, "to get into power." The cheers and jeers were maintained, and when Sir Charles made use of the pronoun "I," the noisy ones repeated it after him. Hissees, cheers, hot words, cries of "Put them out!" followed.

The chairman pounded for order. Laurier's name was cheered, and Sir Charles said: "Those cheers of the Liberals may be used to him about 15 years." He said Mr. Laurier rivalled him in making "I." He had found twenty-three in a short paragraph of three inches. Sir Charles proceeded to discuss Laurier's attitude on many questions and declared that in 1891 he (Sir Charles) had stood by the Government (Laurier) in the unrestricted reciprocity plank of the Liberals would fall. Edward Blake in a letter to him the same time the restriction. Sir John Macdonald said he (Sir Charles) had increased the rate of interest in 1891, only in Kingston enormously in 1891.
