## BEDROOM DOOR WAS BARRICADED

But She Always Kept It So, as She Lived Alone—Inquest Will Be Held.

Mrs. S. J. Mighton, a middle-aged woman, was found dead in her home, 155 Denison-avenue, yesterday morning. Death was due to asphyxiation.

Mrs. Mighton was the wife of a commercial traveler now in Winnipeg. She had been living alone, and the neighbors had seen nothing of her since Monday. Yesterday morning, George Mitchell of the City Water-works office, who lives at No. 157, went along the front room upstairs, and looked into Mrs. Mighton's room. He saw the woman lying dead. Policeman Young was called, and the officer forced the door. The gas jet was turned on full in the room. The constable had some difficulty in getting into the room, as the door was barricaded. This led at first to the theory that it was a case of suicide, but other leads pointed to a different theory. She always made a habit of fastening the door well, as she lived alone.

The police found, in the vestibule, a letter addressed to the dead woman, from her husband. It was written on June 15, from the Hotel Vendome, Winnipeg, and had gone through the Winnipeg Postoffice on the following day. Mr. Mighton asked his wife to go into the room and look at the letter. She reached the room last Sunday, after visiting her husband. Mr. Mighton mentioned his next address as McGregor, Man. and Inspector Stark sent a telegram, shortly after the body was found, to Mr. W. J. Greig issued a warrant for an inquest, but subsequently drew it.

Deceased an inquest necessary, and instructed Coroner W. H. B. Atkins to hold an inquest at 3 o'clock this afternoon.
