TRUMPS ISLAND (Friday's Bay), a fishing settlement in Twillingate district; all connections at or the same as Twillingate, 4 miles; indications of copper; population 30.

TURK'S COVE, a post, fishing and farming settlement in Trinity district; nearest telegraph and money order office Heart's Content; railway station Harbor Grace; coastal steamer Old Perlican by water, or Carbonear by land; population 90.

TURK'S GUT (South Side), in Harbor Main district, and also (North Side), in Port de Grave district, a way office, fishing and farming settlement; nearest money order, telegraph and port of entry Brigus, 2 miles; railway station Salmon Cove; all other connections at or the same as Brigus; population 300.

TURNIP COVE, a fishing settlement in Fortune Bay district; nearest post office Pool's Cove; money order office and coastal steamer Belleoram, 20 miles; connected by sailing packet; telegraph and port of entry St. Jacques; railway station Port au Basque, 170 miles; population 35.

TWILLINGATE (North and South), the capital of the District of Twillingate; a post, money order, telegraph, port of entry, fishing, farming and shipbuilding town; nearest railway station Quinette or Norris' Arm, 58 miles, connected with, by Bay steamer weekly, fare \$1.00, making the distance to St. John's by water and rail 225 miles; coastal mail steamer calls fortnightly from St. John's during the summer months, 232 miles, fares \$7.00 and \$4.00, the rate being about the same by Bay steamer and rail; winter mails weekly by rail and courier; contains 22 fish establishments and smaller stores, 5 or 6 boarding houses, a fine court house with goal and telegraph office under same roof, 6 churches, a number of good schools and halls, is the seat of the rural dean, 2 newspapers, the Twillingate Sun and Northern Standard; has a good bold harbor, but not very safe, with a light-house on Long Point and a harbor light on Government wharf, off of which is fully 15 fathoms of water, with good anchorage; population, including smaller settlements in the vicinity, 3,600.

TWILLINGATE ISLANDS (North Island), connected by government bridge with South Island and contains the following settlements, viz: Twillingate (north), Long Point, Crow Head, Sleepy Cove, Davey Button's Cove, Davis Cove, Back Harbor, Old House Cove, Paradise, Big Wild Cove, Little Wild Cove, Snelling Cove.
