BYE-LAWS

OF

THE AUXILIARY BIBLE SOCIETY OF NEW BRUNSWICK.

I. The Society shall be called the Auxiliary Bible Society of New Brunswick, for the purpose of co-operating with the British and Foreign Bible Society, in promoting the distribution of the Holy Scriptures both at home and abroad.

II. The Bibles and Testaments to be circulated by the Society shall be only those issued and circulated by the Parent

Society.

III. All persons subscribing \$1.00 or upwards per annum shall be members, and all subscribers of \$20.00 or upwards, at any one time, shall be life members. The ministers of all evangelical churches in the city shall be ex officio members of the Society.

IV. The annual meeting shall be held on the third Thursday in May of each year, at which a Board of Management, consisting of not less than twenty members, shall be elected

from various religious denominations.

V. The Board of Management, at their first meeting, shall elect from their number a President, four Vice-Presidents, a Treasurer, and a Secretary for the current year. They shall also appoint a Depository Committee, an Audit Committee, and all other Standing Committees. The Board shall meet quarterly, or as often as business may require, and shall have power to fill all vacancies. Seven members shall constitute a quorum.

VI. THE PRESIDENT.—The President shall preside at all meetings of the Society, countersign all cheques drawn by the Treasurer, and be a member ex officio of all Committees. Special meetings shall be called by him at his discretion, or on the written request of five members.

VICE-PRESIDENTS.—In the absence of the President, any Vice-President may preside and transact all the duties of the office.
