I do reply to your letter of the 18th ult. (No. 4315). I have the honour to submit draft of Advertisement of Sale of the land lately surrendered by the Wyandotts of Anderdon. Also of "Little Turkey Island", previously surrendered.

Lefor, M.P. for the County, who also recommend that each 100 acres be sold separately, as there is much inquiry about the sale, with a prospect of eager competition.
