

## BUTCHERS OF LONDON TO MAKE MUNITIONS

London, June 11—Between 3,00 0and 4,000 men who are employed at the Smithfield meat market in London have volunteered to work four hours a day in turning out munitions of war. A committee formed to put this plan into effect purposes to close the market two hours earlier than at present on four days of the week, to offset partly the increase in working hours.

The associated chambers of agriculture discussed the shortage of labor for gathering the hay crop. It was resolved to appeal to the War Office to send drafts of men accustomed to farm work, under non-commissioned officers, to help the farmers.
