A tidal wave of song is sweeping America. Community singing resounds in every State of the Union, in every province of Canada. Passions of patriotism, grief for our victorious dead, and yearnings for a peace which shall endure, are added to themes of hope and faith, of love and exuberant joy which we have sung from childhood. This new birth of music creates a new need, a golden opportunity.

The churches, in the great field, have garnered their harvest of hymns, and have been forced to sing, during the past fifty years, many "gospel songs" faulty in literary form, and commonplace as music. These compositions in many Christian hymnals have supplanted better works of an earlier day.

Thanks to our educational authorities and their publishers, every pupil in our schools has placed in his hands the true wheat of music, and we find no protection whatever against exploiters of the spurious in music.
