London, Oct. 20—A London newspaper man who made a special visit to Berlin with the object of noting the conditions there has just returned and relate his experiences.

He was arrested several times, but, speaking German well, accomplished his mission without undue difficulty. Describing the aspect of Berlin, he says:

STRONG FHORE

As there has been some misunderstanding and confusion regarding the requirements for recruits for active military service. The Montreal Star has ascertained that the standard required is 5 feet 3 inches in height, with a chest measurement of 33 1-2 inches, and between 18 and 45 years of age. This is the standard for all overseas recruits as well as for home service. The some instances, certain regiments require a higher standard, but this is a matter they are allowed to regulate for themselves, so far as their peace strength is concerned. Any man who might be turned away from one particular regiment for being shorter than their standard, would still be able to collist in many other regiments, provided he came within the militia standard requirement. Some regiments will not take recruits 5 feet 6 inches, and others bar out any who will not measure at least 5 feet 7 inches; but any man who wants to go to the front need not give up hope if he is 5 feet 3 inches tall.


