



## WITH VALUABLES

Trouble for the Hotels

BOSTON, Feb. 18.—On the ground that she had been cruelly treated by her mother and step-father, the Nashua Probate Court has appointed a guardian for Nellie Hazel Mellady, a pretty fifteen-year-old girl who formerly lived in Port Greville, N.S. Mrs. G. H. Kendail, of the Nashua Humane Society, was appointed guardian.

The Mellady child, when six months old, was taken to Port Greville, where she was brought up by Mrs. Allen, her grandmother. Some time ago her mother, a widow, married John Potts, policeman, of Manchester, N.H., and the girl came to live with them two or three years ago. She claims she was ill treated, and on January 23 ran away to Nashua, where the facts were laid before the authorities.
